Day 01: HOME PORTS TO GOOLWA – Sunday 7th March 2010 D

Welcome to our special 5 day tour to *Kangaroo Island*, known as South Australia's "Zoo without Fences". Following hometown pick-ups, we travel via the Western Highway through Horsham, Nhill and Kaniva. After continuing along the Dukes Highway to Tailem Bend we have a short break there and head on to Goolwa for our overnight stop.

Day 02: GOOLWA TO KANGAROO ISLAND – Mon 8th March 2010 B.D

An early start sees us travelling to *Kangaroo Island* from *Cape Jervis*, at the foot of the *Fleurieu Peninsula*, Sailing across *Backstairs Passage* to *Penneshaw*. On arrival to start us off is the *Honey Farm* followed by the *Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery*. From here we drive up to *Kingscote*. This afternoon, we explore *Emu Bay* before stopping at *Cygnets River* and *Island Pure*.

Day 03: THE ZOO WITHOUT FENCES – Tue 9th March 2010 B.L.D

Today we travel to *Seal Bay* for a chance to walk on the beach amongst the colony of *Australian Sea Lions*. This afternoon we visit the *Flinders Chase National Park*, walking via a spectacular board walk, we can see close up a colony of *New Zealand Fur Seals*!

Day 04: KANGAROO ISLAND TO MANNUM – Wed 10th March 2010 B.D

After breakfast catch the mid-morning ferry to Cape Jervis. This afternoon, we head to the heritage town of *Strathalbyn*. We continue via Murray Bridge to Mannum. *Mannum* is one of the oldest towns on the Murray River.
