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**DAY 1: WED 26<sup>TH</sup> MAY D.**  
**HOME TO ADELAIDE**

After our early morning pick up, our first day is spent travelling via the Western Highway through Bordertown and Murray Bridge to Adelaide for our first overnight stop. Dinner tonight will be at a hotel.

**DAY 2: THUR 27<sup>TH</sup> MAY B.L.D.**  
**ADELAIDE TO ROXBY DOWNS**

Early start this morning as we head north through Port Augusta known as the "Crossroads of Australia". Continue on to Woomera, established in 1947 as a launch base for experimental rockets and space crafts. We head further north to Roxby Downs and travel the short distance to Andamooka, and enjoy a town tour and visit an opal showroom and Dukes Bottle House.

**DAY 3: FRI 28<sup>TH</sup> MAY B.L.D.**  
**ROXBY DOWNS TO WILLIAM CREEK**

This morning we enjoy a two hour tour of the Olympic Dam Mine site After an early lunch we leave Roxby Downs via the Borefield Road and join the Oodnadatta Track. Pause at Curdimurka historic railway siding stop to view Lake Eyre South, the lowest land point in Australia Passing Coward Springs we arrive at William Creek for our overnight stop.

**DAY 4: SAT 29<sup>TH</sup> MAY B.L.D.**  
**WILLIAM CREEK TO MARLA**

Continue our trek further north along the Oodnadatta Track stopping at Algebuckina Bridge before arriving in Oodnadatta. Visit the famous Pink Roadhouse and the historic Railway Station before the final leg of our journey today finds us at the top most point of the rugged Oodnadatta Track for our overnight stop at Marla.

**DAY 5: SUN 30<sup>TH</sup> MAY B.L.D.**  
**MARLA TO ALICE SPRINGS**

Joining the Stuart Highway this morning, we cross the South Australia/Northern Territory Border just south of Kulgera. Continue on to Stuarts Well where we visit Camels Australia and enjoy the experience of a camel ride before arriving in Alice Springs our home for the next two nights. Known as the "Heart of the Red Centre", Alice Springs is nestled at the foot of the northern slopes of the MacDonnell Ranges.

**DAY 6: MON 31<sup>ST</sup> MAY B.D.  
EAST MACDONNELL RANGES**

Time this morning for an optional balloon flight where you will experience a beautiful Central Australia sunrise. (At passengers own expense). The rest of the morning is spent discovering the beautiful East MacDonnell ranges. We stop to explore Emily and Jessie Gaps Nature Park. Further on to Trephina Gorge which lies 85km east of Alice Spring. Enjoy a walk through the magnificent gorge. Later we return to Alice Springs and visit the shopping centre for some free time.

**DAY 7: TUE 1<sup>ST</sup> JUNE B.L.D.  
ALICE SPRINGS TO TANAMI TRACK**

Early this morning we begin our adventure across the famous Tanami Track. It travels for 1000km from Alice Springs to Halls Creek. Today we will stop at the Tilmouth Well Roadhouse before continuing on to one of Australia's most remote roadhouses Rabbit Flat.

**DAY 8: WED 2<sup>ND</sup> JUNE B.L.D.  
TANAMI TRACK TO HALLS CREEK**

Today we continue our journey across the Tanami Track and cross the border into Western Australia. Subject to road conditions we will visit Wolfe Creek Crater. This afternoon we arrive at Halls Creek for our overnight accommodation.

**DAY 9: THUR 3<sup>RD</sup> JUNE B.L.  
HALLS CREEK TO BROOME**

Our travel today is via Fitzroy Crossing where we stop at the original crossing over the Fitzroy River and see the Old Crossing Inn Hotel. Continuing on we make our way to Broome for the next two nights. Broome's climate is also something to boast about with warm sunny days and balmy nights.

**DAY 10: FRI 4<sup>TH</sup> JUNE B  
BROOME**

Today is a totally free day to do some of your own exploring around Broome. Maybe you may wish to take a scenic flight to the magnificent Horizontal Waterfalls and Cape Leveque with sensational views of the rugged coastline. Or perhaps go for a stroll along the famous Cable Beach.

**DAY 11: SAT 5<sup>TH</sup> JUNE B.L.D.  
BROOME TO MT ELIZABETH STATION**

Today we begin our trek along the famous Gibb River Road another of Western Australia's well known stock routes. The road cuts through the King Leopold Range, Phillips Range, Barnett Range, Gibb Range, Mosquito Hills, Pentecost Range and Cockburn Range. Later today we arrive at Mount Elizabeth Station, approximately half way along the Gibb River Road.

**DAY 12: SUN 6<sup>TH</sup> JUNE B.L.D  
MT ELIZABETH STATION**

This morning our group will split into two. While one group spends the morning relaxing at the station homestead, the other will enjoy a 4 WD tour to a nearby scenic gorge. Bring your bathers as there's a waterhole close by. This afternoon our groups swap over.

**DAY 13: MON 7<sup>TH</sup> JUNE B.L.D  
MT ELIZABETH STATION TO KUNUNURRA**

Early start this morning as we continue heading east along the Gibb River Road. Late afternoon we arrive at Kununurra where we board our boat for a Sunset B.B.Q Dinner Cruise. We will be tempted with locally grown "Fruits of the Ord" and a little croc spotting on the return journey.

**DAY 14: TUE 8<sup>TH</sup> JUNE B.L.D  
BUNGLE BUNGLES FLIGHTS**

Today we enjoy our scenic flight over Kununurra and the surrounding area as we fly out to the Bungle Bungles. From the air we see the renowned Ord Irrigation area, the mighty Ord River and the enormous man made Lake Argyle as well as the surrounding Kimberley's. Upon arriving at the Bungle Bungles we will transfer to our air conditioned 4 WD. On our walk into Cathedral Gorge you will be amazed as you are surrounded by the Beehive Domes for which the park is so famous for. Following our afternoon tea we rejoin the aircraft for our return flight to Kununurra. Flying over the Argyle Diamond Mine we complete what is certainly going to be a memorable day.

**DAY 15: WED 9<sup>TH</sup> JUNE B.L.D  
KUNUNURRA TO KATHERINE**

A leisurely start this morning as we farewell Kununurra and cross the border into the Northern Territory as we begin our journey to Katherine. The drive passes the historic Timber Creek area and the Victoria River Districts sprawling cattle country.. Later this afternoon we arrive in Katherine for our overnight stop.

**DAY 16: THUR 10<sup>TH</sup> JUNE B.L.D  
KATHERINE TO TENNANT CREEK**

A relaxed day today as our travels take us along the famous Stuart Highway to Mataranka. Here we will visit the Mataranka Homestead where you will have time for a swim in the thermal pools before continuing on through Daly Waters and Elliott. Further on through Three Ways we arrive at Tennant Creek.

**DAY 17: FRI 11<sup>TH</sup> JUNE B.L.D  
TENNANT CREEK TO ALICE SPRINGS**

Today we head south to the Devils Marbles Conservation Reserve. Later we pass Barrow Creek, Central Mount Stuart and the Tropic of Capricorn before arriving in Alice Springs our home for the next two nights. Dinner tonight is at the famous Overland Steakhouse.

**DAY 18: SAT 12TH JUNE**

**ALICE SPRINGS SIGHTSEEING**

Our first visit this morning is the National Pioneer Women's Hall of Fame. Following this we make our way to the Alice Springs Cultural Precinct, home to some of the most interesting cultural and historical attractions in Alice Springs.
